What's Good for Me

We all go through stages in life and situations where we resist doing what is best for ourselves. When we were little, if given the option, we would all eat our preferred food for every meal instead of having a balanced diet because we didn't know any better. Many children would choose sweets over vegetables any day of the week. When we get older, we may reach a point where we should put our care in the hands of others because we can no longer make those decisions for ourselves; yet we resist. Our reasons for resistance are numerous. We resist because of ignorance, our own preferences, giving up our independence, and so on.

In 1 John 2:1-6, John reminds us of at least three different ways that He is leading us towards what is in our best interest. He is our advocate, our propitiation, and our example. If God is working so hard to tell me what is best for me, provide me the best option possible, and show me how to practice it, then why do I still resist Him? Once again, the possibilities are numerous, but perhaps it all boils down to not being convinced that He has our best interests in mind. Jesus is our advocate because we need someone to be by our side when we mess up (1 John 2:1); Jesus is our propitiation because our decisions have rendered us hopeless without His intervention (2:1); Jesus is our example because we need guidance to live a life of in harmony with God's intended outcome (2:3-6). That sounds to me like someone who wants as many people in the world to succeed as possible. We need to trust that God knows what is good for us. Our trust in Him will produce a result that we are incapable of accomplishing on our own in perpetuity. In Love, Sage
