UNEQUALLY YOKED

There are times when a person must speak out, even when it may be unpopular, even when his beloved friends may disagree with him, and even when he may suffer negative repercussions.

Recently the majority of the men present at a business meeting voted to lease part of the church property to the county, and it was presented to the church as "this is what we have decided to do."

Few specifics were given, there was no discussion of the pros and cons, no input was requested from the congregation, and the resulting blowback indicates there is no consensus among the brethren for this.

Under the law tenants may do anything on a leased property that is not illegal or contrary to the terms of the lease, and this is true whether or not their future conduct may violate the Scriptures.

Also, once a landlord grants a tenant the option to extend a lease, it cannot be revoked; this means that a "five-year lease" could conceivably encumber the property for twenty years or more.

And if any of our members are asked to supervise the renovations the county requires, it would create a conflict of interest which would make the church responsible for any problems that may arise.

However, the money offered is very attractive to some brethren (see Matthew 6:24), and this is why:

Our current minister only gets about 85% of the pay that any other minister would receive to do the same work, and he also holds a second job so the church does not have to cover his medical insurance.

This is all we can afford at this time, but with the extra lease money, it would become possible to hire a much more highly paid individual, and that would make it so much easier to fire our present minister.

And the way things are going in our state, there could be a day when the county will decide to put a banner across their portion of our building to celebrate "Gay Pride Week".

Is this what you want? Get a copy of the proposed lease agreement before it is signed. Read it. Ask questions. Understand it. Tell the church leadership what you think (I Thesalonians 5:21 and 22).

"Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?" (II Corinthians 6:14 and 15). —Jim Crooks


