TAKING THE TRAIN

My first close-up encounter with the iron horse was when I was five years old.

The Missouri-Kansas-Texas (M-K-T, or 'The Katy') Railroad had a spur from Altus, Oklahoma, that ended in Texas with a large mile-long "Y", one leg of which stopped at the back of my Granddad's barn.

One morning a massive steam locomotive pulled right up to the end of this track, and it was making all kinds of loud noises, rumbling and hissing and spewing out great clouds of hot steam.

Then the engineer cut loose with the screaming, ear-piercing whistle to signal the brakeman at the other end to throw the switch, and I was so startled that I jumped and ran for dear life towards the house.

When I heard my Granddad laughing, I stopped and watched as the engineer spun the huge drive wheels backwards twice before they got traction, and the engine began to chug-chug-chug back down the track.

According to my Dad, the best sleeping in the world is on a moving train; he had crossed the country twice from coast to coast on a train at the beginning of World War II when he was in the Navy.

The clackety-clack of the wheels on the rails with the car swinging back and forth as it travels down the tracks seems to be very much akin to the motion of a rocking baby crib.

I found this to be true when I took my family back to Texas on Amtrak for the Christmas holidays; it was our first time in a Pullman compartment, and the gentle swaying of the train put us quickly to sleep.

When we awakened the next morning, we got dressed and made our way up to the dining car, and as we ate breakfast, our train wound through the beautiful mountains near Flagstaff just after a big snowstorm.

Our Christmas vacation had truly become a "white Christmas".



Submitting your name/s to the church will be kept confidential and Linda will not be asking you for any financial information.
