Idolatry isn't Outdated

When we hear the word "idolatry", it would be easy to think that the speaker is referring to a sin that took place long ago in a land far away; however, when we consider the roots of idolatry, it may be closer to home than we think. The Bible teaches that self-interest is at the center of idolatry. Paul says that greed amounts to idolatry, which results in the wrath of God (Col. 3:5, 6). He also says in the book of Ephesians that a covetous person is an idolator and does not have an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ (5:5). These are just a couple of examples where the Bible links together the idea of selfish tendencies begetting idolatry.

You may be thinking, "I have never participated in idolatry" because you have never burned incense to an ancient Greek or Roman god or goddess. Paul would say that we are missing the point. In a variety of ways, selfishness causes us to make God in our image instead of us in His. Let's study together this morning to see how we can keep idolatry out of our worship and out of our lives.
