**Soaring Above Life's Storms**

*"Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, walk and not be faint." -Isaiah 40:30, 31*

An eagle knows of the approaching storm long before it strikes. It flies to some high spot and waits for the wind to begin. When the storm does hit, the eagle sets its wings so that it is lifted above the storm. When the storm rages below, it is soaring high above it. The eagle doesn't escape the storm, but uses the storm to lift it higher.

Isaiah compares people to eagles. God makes it possible for us to catch the winds and soar above life's storms. We set our minds and beliefs towards God. We don't let the storms overcome us! God's power lifts us above them, and our strength is renewed. The strength offered is the solid foundation of God's word (Matt. 7:24-27).

It is not that we won't be affected by the storms. We will not only be affected, but in them. Yet these storms will be used to help us grow spiritually. May we not allow hope to fade nor faith to weaken. God will always be with us (Heb. 13:5), and will help us "soar on wings like eagles."
