

Lightning



We see a tremendous flash in the sky, followed by loud thunder. We may comment, "That was sure close!" There is a frequency around the earth of 100 flashes of lightning every second. That means there are at least 8,640,000 every day. Christ had a perfect knowledge of Satan (Lk 10:18). He knew all his limitations, and how his fall was sudden and swift. Satan's defeated! He's overcome by the Lamb's blood and the words spoken confirming belief in Jesus Christ (Rev. 12:11). Satan fell before the power of the Lord's army and the victory in their Captain! 
